

Topic - Adult and Baby Animals

Some adult animals look very similar to their babies. Some look very different! Can you think of different examples for both?

Here, the adult is called a dog, and the baby is called a puppy. The puppy looks like a smaller version of the adult.



Here, the adult is called a butterfly, and the baby is called a caterpillar. They look completely different!
