

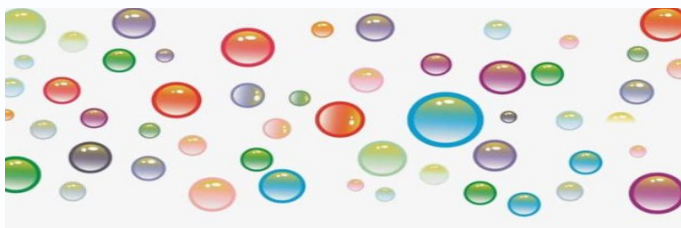


Welcome back!!

This leaflet contains very important information about some changes to the routines of the school day. Please read it and keep it in a safe place so you can refer to it again. Write down any questions you may have and ask your adult when you . You can also email your class teacher.

School in Bubble

In school, you will be in small groups called **'bubbles'** and each will have up to 10 children. You will do all your learning, play and having your lunch in your bubbles. For your own safety and that of others, you will not be allowed to mix with children from other bubble groups. Your seating arrangement will be different as you are likely to have a table to yourself. Some of the furniture and resources in the classrooms have been moved out so there is enough room to keep your distance from each other.



One-Way System

A one-way system has been marked out on the drive. You must respect this at all times to promote your safety and that of others.



Timings

There will be different start and finish times for different year groups.

- Nursery— 08:30 to 11:30
- Reception— 09:15 to 14:45
- Year 1— 09:00 to 14:30
- Year 6—09:30 to 15:30



VERY IMPORTANT

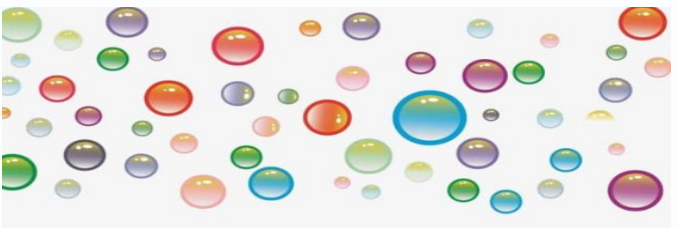
You must only use the gate that has been assigned to your year group to enter and exit the premises.

- Nursery— Pedestrian Entrance on the side of the main gate
- Reception & Year 1—Main gate
- Year 6—KS2 pupil path entrance (pupils only)



After School

There will be no after school clubs or Funzone sessions this term. You must leave the school as soon as your class is dismissed. You must not be seen mingling with children or adults from other bubbles.

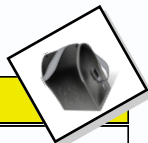

Water Bottles



Bring your own water bottles to school everyday. This must be labelled and filled with water from home. In school, you will keep your water bottle on your table. At the end of the day, you will be asked to take them home, clean and refill for the next school day.

Stationery



You will not be allowed to bring book bags or pencil cases to school. In class, you will be given all the stationery you require to complete your tasks. These cannot be taken out of the classroom and must be handed back to your teacher.

Uniform



You are allowed to come to school in your own clothes, but you must wear fresh, clean clothes everyday. We will prefer you wearing trainers rather than school shoes so you can engage in outdoor sports.

P.E. Kit



You will not be changing into your P.E. kits so please keep them at home

Lunches



Reception and Year 1 will be given a free packed lunch in school. Year 6 pupils can also have a free packed lunch or bring their own. If you choose to bring your own, you must lock your lunch boxes away in your lockers.

Lunches will be eaten in bubble groups.

There will be a choice of a

- Main component -sandwich, wraps etc
- Vegetables—carrot sticks, celery , cherry tomatoes etc
- Fruit—apple, orange, plum etc
- Dessert— crackers and cheese, yoghurt, homemade cake, etc
- Carton of juice



Be Safe

Use a tissue to catch your cough and sneezes, bin it and wash your hands well after.

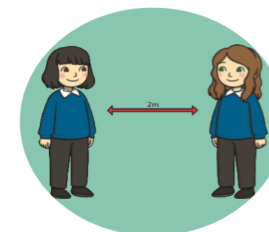
Always maintain a safe distance of at least 2metres between you, your friends and adults.
